


Funding needed

Assumptions

- It costs 72,000/= to raise a goat @ year.
- A goat consumes 3% of it's weight & drinks 1.5 ltrs of water.
- Kidding percentage of 180.
- A mature goat excretes 0.3 tones of manure @ year.
- A mature goat excretes 0.3 tones of manure @ year.

20% ROI

Return on Investment

- Assuming 300 goats born on the ranch are sold @ 120,000/=
- It costs 72,000/= to raise a goat @ year.
- Each nanny was procured @ 240,000/=.
